- An international network of trainers and wine schools.

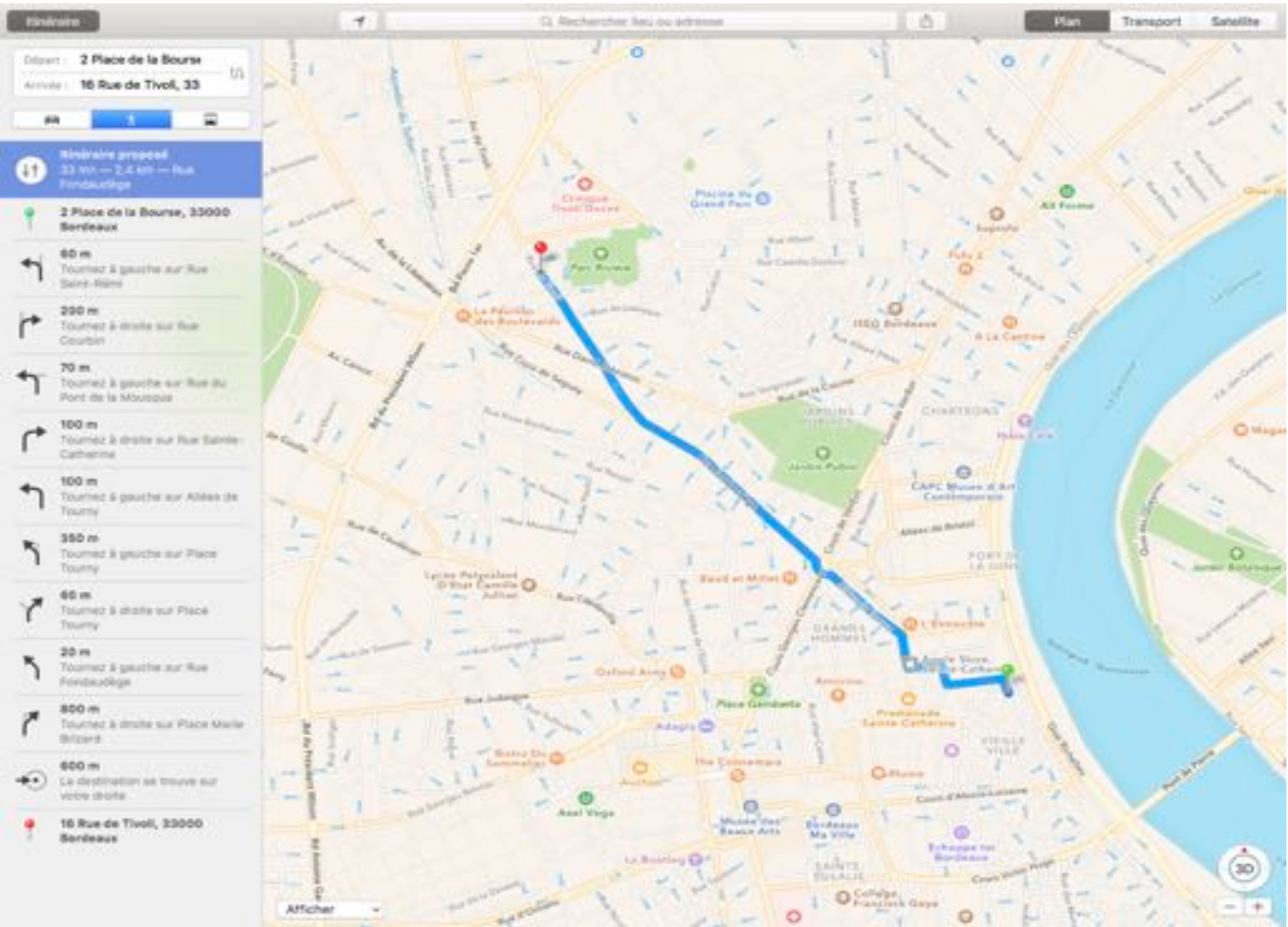

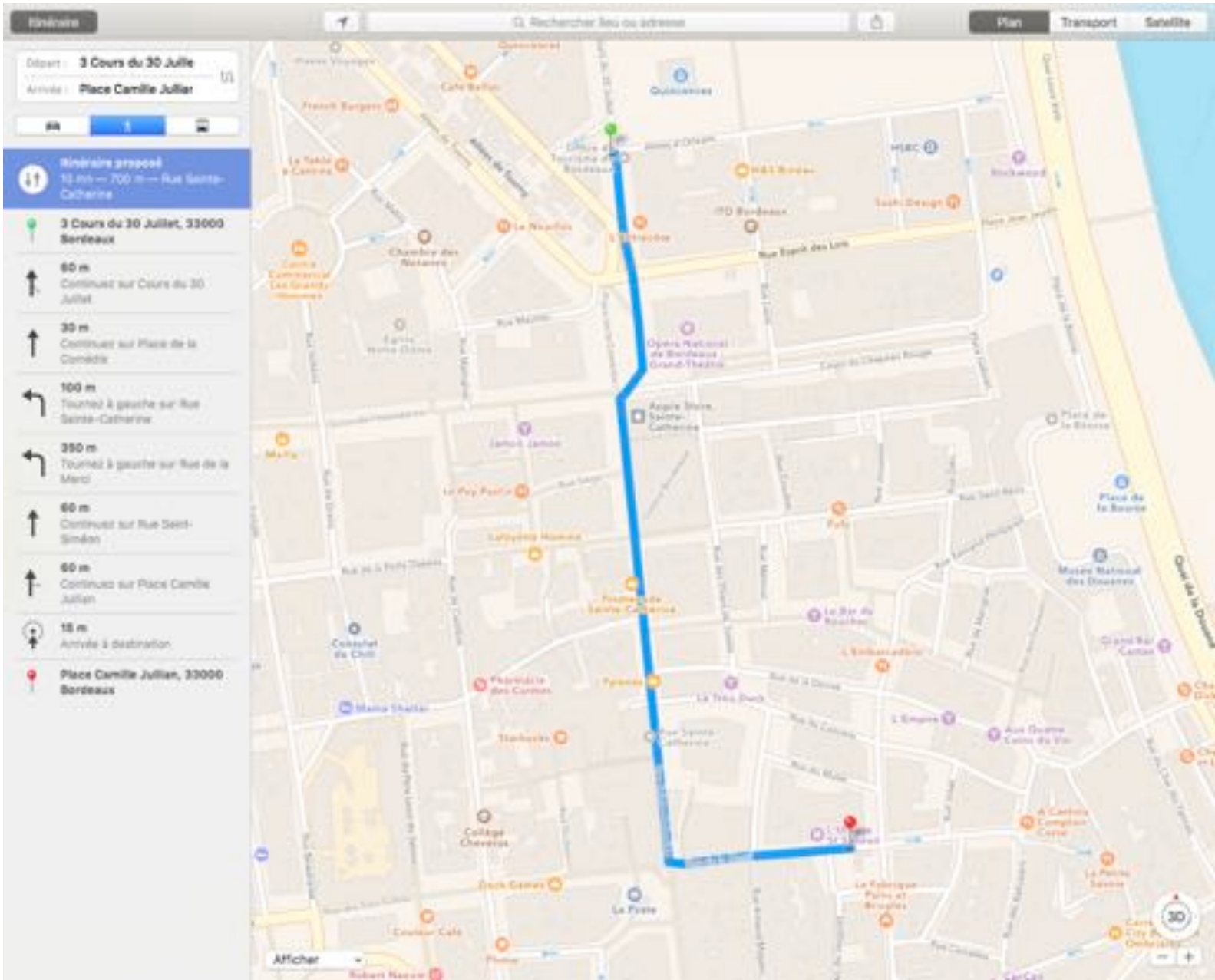

Bordeaux World Heritage is a cultural place, Interpretation Centre of Architecture and Heritage (CIAAH), located in the heart of 150 hectares of protected area. Opened in February 2014, it is an invitation to travel through time and urban geography for an audience of tourists from Bordeaux ages. Throughout the exhibition, you will discover the history of Bordeaux, the various stages of its development and key events which have influenced its construction. Bordeaux World Heritage also plans around the city numerous and urban projects, and in the dream quarter by many architects and urban planners. Young and old will enjoy measurements CGI, tablets, video projections and film crossing documents archives, models and plans. Everyone can come to learn about ongoing projects and discover the evolution of the city or its neighborhood, regularly updated according to current events.
